The ISACS Network values the growth of professional, equitable and safe working practices among its membership. If a member repeatedly and egregiously operates contrary to these values, the ISACS Board of Directors reserves the right to suspend membership to the ISACS network. E.g: Non-payment for agreed work in a timely and efficient manner.

ISACS is committed to ensuring that any concerns or complaints relating to member conduct are handled confidentially, fairly, and in a timely manner. Where concerns are raised regarding a potential breach of the Code of Conduct or behaviour inconsistent with the organisation's values, the Board will review the matter in accordance with the principles of procedural fairness. This includes providing all parties with an appropriate opportunity to be heard and to respond to any concerns before a decision is made.
